Vision

The goal of this Bible reading plan is to unite the congregation in a shared journey through the Word of God. We want to encourage one another to read the Bible regularly, deepen our understanding, and strengthen our relationship with God—both individually and as a community.

When we read the same passages at the same time, it creates a common foundation for conversation, prayer, and spiritual growth. The Word becomes not only personal nourishment but also a shared experience that strengthens our unity. We believe that the Word of God is living and active, as it says in Hebrews 4:12, and that it transforms our lives when we open our hearts to it.

The theme of each month helps us dive deeper into the truths of Scripture and allows the Word to shape our mindset and our lives. The center of our faith is Jesus Christ—who died and rose again to give us life, hope, and salvation.

1. Wednesday

Matt. 1:23

Reflection: *Jesus reminds us that His path involves suffering and sacrifice, but also victory and new life.*

Prayer: *Lord, give me faith to trust You even when I do not understand Your way, and to wait for the resurrection You promise.*

2. Thursday

Matt. 27:37

Reflection: *Although Jesus was called “King of the Jews” in mockery and suffering, it is there that His true kingship is revealed: a love that sacrifices itself for others.*

Prayer: *Lord, help me to see You as my true King and to live in love and humility today.*

3. Friday

Mark. 9:31

Hugleiðing: *Jesús opinberar að jafnvel í erfiðleikum og dauða er Guð að vinna að stærri áætlun um líf og sigur.*

Bæn: *Drottinn, hjálpaðu mér að treysta á þína áætlun, jafnvel þegar leiðin er þung og óskiljanleg.*

4. Saturday

Ezek. 37:13

Reflection: *God brings life where everything seems dead and without hope.*

Prayer: *Lord, breathe new life into what has become dry and weak in my life, and fill me with Your hope.*

5.Sunday

Jh. 11:25

Reflection: Jesus is not only the one who gives life—He is life itself, and in Him we find a hope that overcomes even death.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help me to trust in You as the resurrection and the life, and to live in that hope and certainty every day.

6.Monday

Rev. 1:8

Reflection: Jesus is the beginning and the end—He holds everything in His hands from start to finish.

Prayer: Lord, help me to trust You with my whole life, from the beginning to the end.

7.Tuesday

Eph. 1:22

Reflection: Jesus leads the church with wisdom and love as its true head.

Prayer: Lord, guide me to follow You and to be part of Your body in unity and faith.

8.Wednesday

Sal. 118:22

Reflection: What was rejected becomes the foundation—Jesus is the cornerstone of life.

Prayer: Lord, help me to build my life upon You, the firm cornerstone.

9.Thursday

Rom. 11:26

Reflection: Jesus comes as the Savior who sets us free from sin and darkness.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for salvation—help me to live in Your freedom.

10.Friday

Rom. 11:26

Reflection: Jesus is the light that dawns and brings the hope of a new day.

Prayer: Lord, let Your light shine in my life and guide me forward.

11.Saturday

Jh. 8:58

Reflection: Jesus is eternal—He is the “I AM,” the very presence.

Prayer: Lord, help me to trust in You as the eternal and unchanging One.

12.Sunday

Jh. 8:12

Reflection: In Jesus, we find the light that drives away darkness.

Prayer: Lord, light my path and make me a light to others.

13.Monday

Jh. 1:14

Reflection: Jesus is the truth that reveals God and guides us on the right path.

Prayer: Lord, lead me in Your truth and help me to live according to it.

14.Tuesday

Matt. 2:15

Reflection: Jesus is the Son of God, sent in love to save the world.

Prayer: Lord, thank You for Your Son—help me to receive Him with faith.

15.Wednesday

Heb. 2:10

Reflection: *Jesus leads us to salvation as the perfect leader.*

Prayer: *Lord, guide me on the path of Your salvation and strengthen my faith.*

16.Thursday

Isa. 9:6

Reflection: *Jesus is the Wonderful Counselor who gives wisdom and direction.*

Prayer: *Lord, guide me with Your wisdom in all my decisions.*

17.Friday

Isa. 26:4

Reflection: *God is the eternal rock in whom we can trust.*

Prayer: *Lord, strengthen me to rest in You and to trust in You always.*

18.Saturday

Rev. 19:13

Reflection: *Jesus is the living Word of God who speaks truth into our lives.*

Prayer: *Lord, open my heart to Your Word and let it transform me.*

19.Sunday

Jh. 10:11

Reflection: *Jesus is the Good Shepherd who knows, guides, and protects His sheep. He gave His life for us and gives us life in abundance. To follow Him is to live under the care of the perfect Shepherd.*

Prayer: *Jesus, thank You for being the Good Shepherd. Guide my life and help me to always follow You.*

20.Monday

Jh. 1:3

Reflection: *All things were created through Jesus and for Him.*

Prayer: *Lord, help me to see Your creation and to live in gratitude.*

21.Tuesday

1.Cor 10:4

Reflection: *Jesus is the rock who gives us stability and strength.*

Prayer: *Lord, be my rock and my strength in every circumstance.*

22.Wednesday

Rev. 1:17

Reflection: *Jesus is above all—He is the beginning and the end.*

Prayer: *Lord, help me to put You first in my life.*

23.Thursday

Lk. 9:20

Reflection: *Jesus is the anointed Messiah whom God has sent.*

Prayer: *Lord, help me to confess You as the Christ in my life.*

24.Friday

Matt 1:21

Reflection: *The name of Jesus means salvation—He saves His people from their sins.*

Prayer: *Lord Jesus, thank You for the salvation You give me.*

25.Saturday

Is. 40:3

Reflection: *The Lord comes with power and presence to His people.*

Prayer: *Lord, prepare my heart to receive You.*

26.Sunday

Jh. 6:26-35

Reflection: *Jesus teaches that true bread is not only physical food. He Himself is the bread that gives eternal life. Whoever believes in Him will never be spiritually empty.*

Prayer: *Lord Jesus, thank You because in You we find true life. Help me to trust in You each day.*

27.Monday

Dan. 9:25

Reflection: *Jesus is the promised Messiah whom God announced throughout the ages. In Him, we see that God does not forget His promises, but fulfills them in the perfect time.*

Prayer: *Lord, strengthen my faith as I wait on You and help me to trust that You always fulfill Your promises in due time.*

28.Tuesday

Jh. 1:14

Reflection: *Jesus is the Prince of Peace who not only brings outward peace, but a deep inner peace that remains firm despite circumstances. His peace does not depend on what happens around us, but on who He is. In Him, we find rest for our souls.*

Prayer: *Lord, teach me to rest in Your peace and to seek it instead of trying to control everything on my own.*

29. Wednesday

Rev. 3:14

Reflection: Jesus is the “Amen,” the faithful and true witness—He is the perfect confirmation of everything God has spoken. In a world where many things are uncertain and constantly changing, Jesus is the firm foundation of truth upon which we can build our lives.

Prayer: Lord, help me to stand firm in Your truth and to trust in You even when everything else seems uncertain.

30. Thursday

Judg. 6:24

Reflection: God reveals Himself as “Shalom”—a peace that encompasses our whole being, not just the absence of conflict, but wholeness, healing, and fullness. His peace touches the heart, the mind, and every part of life, restoring what is broken.

Prayer: Lord, fill me with Your peace that heals, strengthens, and renews my whole life.

Theme of the Month: Who is Jesus?

Jesus Christ is one of the most influential figures in human history and has had a profound impact on faith, culture, and morality around the world. According to the Christian faith, He is the Son of God and the Savior of humanity. He was born in Bethlehem about 2,000 years ago and grew up in Nazareth. His life and teachings are recorded in the New Testament of the Bible. Jesus has many names that reflect His role and significance; for example, He is called Savior, Christ, Son of God, Lord, the Good Shepherd, and the Light of the world.

Jesus taught about love, forgiveness, and mercy. He emphasized the importance of loving one's neighbor as oneself and helping those in need.
