Vision

The goal of this Bible reading plan is to unite the congregation in a shared journey through the Word of God. We want to encourage one another to read the Bible regularly, deepen our understanding, and strengthen our relationship with God—both as individuals and as a community.

When we read the same passages at the same time, a common foundation is created for conversation, prayer, and encouragement. The Word becomes not only personal nourishment but also a shared experience that strengthens our unity. We believe that the Word of God is living and powerful, as stated in Hebrews 4:12, and that it transforms our lives when we open our hearts to it.

The theme of the month helps us dive deeper into the truths of Scripture and allows the Word to shape our mindset and our lives. At the center of our faith is Jesus Christ—who died and rose again to give us salvation hope and life.

Our hope is that this reading plan will be a tool that helps the congregation grow in faith, knowledge, and love, and that the Word of God will be a light on our path and the foundation of our community.

1.Sunday

Eph. 6:10-18

Reflection: *“In God I receive strength to stand firm, even when the battle is unseen.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, clothe me in Your peace and faith today, and keep me steady in You.”*

2.Monday

Isa. 59:17a

Reflection: *“God is clothed in righteousness and salvation, and invites me to trust His work rather than my own strength.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to live in Your righteousness and trust in Your salvation today.”*

3.Tuesday

Ps. 18:3

Reflection: *“When I call on the Lord, I am not alone, for He is my refuge and strength in every trouble.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, I call on You today—be my refuge, my strength, and my deliverer.”*

4.Wednesday

Rom. 13:12

Reflection: *“God calls me to leave the darkness behind and live in His light with a pure heart and renewed strength.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to lay aside the darkness and clothe myself in Your light today.”*

5.Thursday.

1. Thess. 5:8

Reflection: *“I belong to the day and am called to be watchful in faith and love, with hope as a shield over my heart.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, strengthen my faith, fill me with love, and keep my hope alive today.”*

Zec. 4:6

Reflection: *“God’s work is not accomplished by my strength, but by His Spirit who carries me when I am weak.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, teach me to trust in Your Spirit and lead me in what You are calling me to do.”*

Reflection: *“God Himself walks with me in the battle, and victory rests in His presence, not in my fear.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to trust that You fight for me and give me victory.”*

Reflection: *“Christ is our truth and righteousness. In Him we stand secure.”*

Prayer: *“I receive Your Word with faith, Lord. Amen.”*

Reflection: *“When righteousness and faithfulness surround me, my life learns to stand firm in God.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, clothe me in Your righteousness and faithfulness in everything I do today.”*

10.Tuesday

Reflection: *“The truth sets us free from deception and fear. When we live in God’s truth, we experience real life.”*

Prayer: *“Father, teach me to walk in Your truth. Amen.”*

11.Wednesday

Prov 4:23

Reflection: *“God wants to guard our hearts, for from them flows life. Righteousness helps us live with pure intentions.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, guard my heart. Amen.”*

12.Thursday

Reflection: *“Integrity strengthens our spiritual life. When we walk in righteousness, we honor God in everything.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to live with integrity. Amen.”*

Prayer: *“Father, establish my steps in Your peace. Amen.”*

Reflection: *“The peace of God guards our hearts even in difficulties. We trust in His presence.”*

Prayer: *“I want to rest in Your peace, Lord. Amen.”*

17.Tuesday

Ps. 37:5

Reflection: *“When we commit our ways to God, we move forward in trust and peace.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, I commit my ways to You. Amen.”*

Reflection: *“The peace of Christ governs our hearts and our responses.”*

Prayer: *“Let Your peace rule in my life. Amen.”*

Reflection: *“Victory in Christ leads me into fellowship, authority, and closeness with Him.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, strengthen me to overcome and follow You all the way to the end.”*

22.Sunday

Eph 6:16

Reflection: *“Faith protects us against fear and doubt. We choose to trust God.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, strengthen my faith. Amen.”*

23.Monday

Prov. 3:5–6

Reflection: *“We prepare our hearts by trusting in God.”*

Prayer: *“I affirm my faith in You. Amen.”*

24.Tuesday

2.Cor. 2:14

Reflection: *“In Christ, God leads me in triumph, even when I do not understand the way.”*

Prayer: *“God, lead me in the victory of Christ and let my life carry His fragrance.”*

25.Wednesday

Luc 18:1

Reflection: *“God calls us not to give up in prayer.”*

Prayer: *“Give me perseverance in prayer, Lord. Amen.”*

26.Thursday

Prov. 18:10-11

Reflection: *“The name of the Lord is a safe refuge, and only in Him do I find true security.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to seek refuge in You rather than in my own strength.”*

27.Friday

Rev. 3:21

Reflection: *“To overcome in Christ is to walk the path of obedience that ends in fellowship and glory with Him.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, give me perseverance to overcome and remain faithful to You until the very end.”*

28.Saturday

Rom 10:17

Reflection: *“God’s promise is not based on my works but on faith that trusts in His grace.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, strengthen my faith to live in Your promises.”*

29.Sunday

Eph 6:17-18

Reflection: *“God’s Word is my weapon, and my prayer is the breath of faith that keeps me alert in the battle.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, fill me with Your Word and teach me to pray continually in Your Spirit.”*

30.Monday

Zeph 3:17

Reflection: *“Although I may feel weak or afraid, the Lord is still with me, and He is the hero who fights for me and saves me.”*

Prayer: *“Lord my God, thank You that You are with me and that You are the hero who saves; help me to trust You and fill me with strength and peace today, amen.”*

31.Tuesday

Col.1:13-14

Reflection: *“God has brought me out of darkness into light and has given me freedom and forgiveness in Christ.”*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to live in the light and freedom You have given me.”*

Theme – The Armor of God

The words in Ephesians 6:10–20 remind us that life is not only what meets the eye. The battle we face daily is often not against circumstances or people, but against fear, hopelessness, misconceptions, and everything that pulls us away from living in truth and love. Paul does not call us to fight in our own strength, but to be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. There lies the key: we are not alone.

The armor of God is not a weapon of attack but of steadfastness. Truth keeps us standing upright when lies try to undermine our identity. Righteousness guards our hearts and reminds us that our worth is not based on performance but on grace. The peace proclaimed in the gospel enables us to take confident steps, even on uncertain paths.

The shield of faith is especially important in times when flaming arrows of doubt and anxiety fly at us from every direction. The helmet of salvation protects our minds and reminds us of a hope that reaches beyond the present moment. The sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God, guides us when we do not know which way to go.

All of this, however, is wrapped in prayer. In prayer we connect to the source of strength. There we learn to stand, not in harshness, but in trust.

Weekly Prayer Meetings

Every week we offer prayer meetings that are open to everyone. We come together to seek God, pray for one another, for the church, and for our community. These are precious times where we are strengthened in faith and unity.
